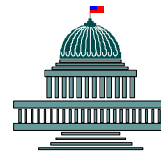




HERE ARE SOME GENERAL STEPS TO HOW **Laws** ARE MADE:

Laws are rules that everyone has to follow.

1) An idea for a **Law** goes to the State House



2) The idea is presented as a **Bill** and gets sent to a **Committee**



3) The **Committee** hears the **Testimony** of anyone who want to talk about the bill



LIST SOME WAYS YOU CAN TELL THE COMMITTEE HOW **YOU** WANT THEM TO VOTE ABOUT A BILL:

4) The **Committee** votes on the **Bill**



NO = stops the bill



YES = Bill goes to full House and Senate



5) The House and Senate vote on the **Bill**

VOTE



NO = bill does NOT become a law



YES = bill goes to Governor

6) If the Governor votes NO it is called a VETO. A vetoed bill does NOT become a law.

If the Governor votes YES, the bill becomes a law.
