Tip for Attendees

From the 2016 Conference Planning Committee

Bring a photo ID

If you are staying overnight, you may need to show this at check-in, or if you get locked out of your room.

Plan Your Schedule Ahead of Time

Share the schedule with whoever is helping you get there or double check the bus schedule and RIDE. Don't wait until the last minute to find out if you need a ride.

Be Prepared with Your Medication

Bring any medication that you need to take during the conference so you don't have to leave early. If you're carpooling, ask your friends to do this, too!

Bring Some Money for Any of the Following

- Meals, snacks & drinks that are not part of your conference registration. This includes money for a cash bar that will be open during the dinner dance. FYI: soda is NOT served at the conference meals, but you can buy it in the hotel if needed.
- Money for the conference sales table. We will have zip-up hooded sweatshirts, T-shirts, bracelets, hats and other items on sale this year. Prices range from \$5.00 \$25.00.

A Credit Card is Optional

If you are staying overnight, you only need to give the hotel your credit card if you want to charge things to your room. Hotel restaurant, the cash bar and the conference sales table also accept credit cards. It's up to you!
