


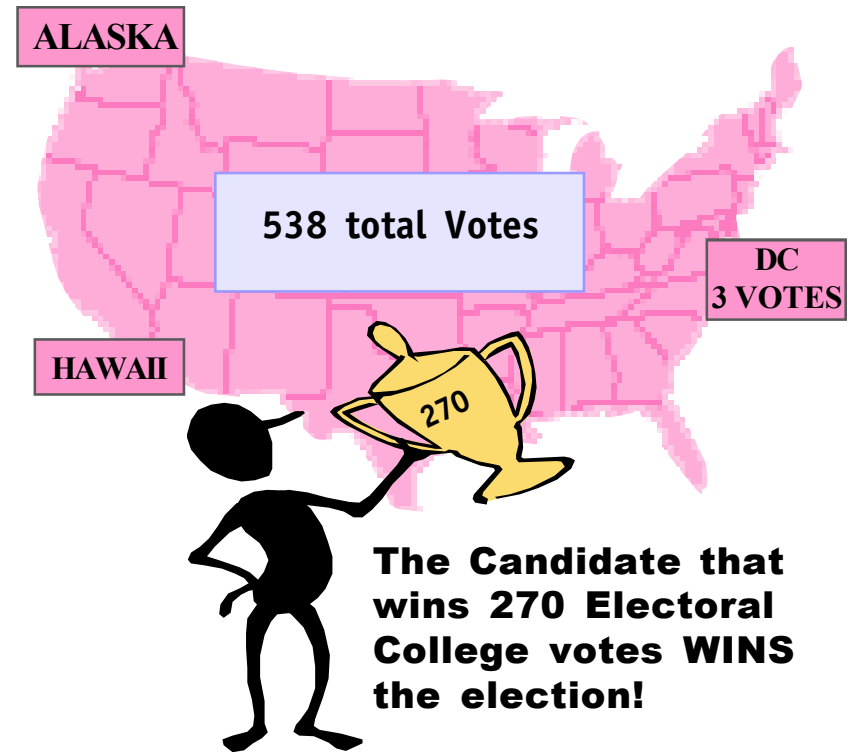

THE ELECTORAL COLLEGE

- * It's NOT a school
- * It's how we elect the President.

POPULAR VOTES = The actual number of votes (one from each voter) that a candidate wins.

 = ONE VOTE

**** WINNER TAKES ALL:**
The candidate that wins the most popular votes in a state wins ALL of that state's Electoral Votes.



ELECTORAL VOTES = The number of votes each State can give to a candidate who is running for President.

* The number of Electoral College votes that a state has is equal to the number of Senators (2) and Representatives (depends on the population) that it has.

For example: Rhode Island has 2 Senators and 2 Representatives, so RI has 4 Electoral College Votes.



+ = 4 Electoral Votes from Rhode Island
